Isaiah 42:9 tells us we have the right to expect something new from the Lord every day, and we can expect to have more and more experiences of God's goodness.

It says nothing compares to what He is going to do. So what He is about to do means there is no comparison as to what He is about to do. Think of all the good things God has already done. But what we have seen up to this point, it's nothing compared to what He is going to do.

We need to expect and declare for the greater things of God. This is a new season and it is going to get greater and greater in every area of our lives. There is a new wave that is here and we are in the midst of it now.

Ps. 115:12-14 says you are blessed of the Lord. It means increase, more and more. The Lord shall increase you more and more. Increase means greater and greater. God will take you from nothing to something!

We want to be greater in so many ways. We want to have more and more people come to a saving knowledge of Jesus. We want to see people healed of everything! We want to see people hunger for the Lord, hunger for His Word and of course hunger to know Him!

I was weak and tired and I didn't want to goof up the trip for my husband and the couple who was going with us.

My hubby had been wanting me to go to Europe with him for several years and he had already paid for the tickets. I tried to warn our friends that I just didn't know how much I could do. I had to believe God that I could even walk in the airport to get to wherever we needed to be.

It was very hard to walk because I was so weak. There were days that I just kept saying, "The Lord is my strength" over and over. It got me through some difficult times. My hubby was understanding and I had favor with him. He would drive me as close to the door of the area where we were going as he could. He didn't get mad when I couldn't walk another step without a few minutes rest. He gave up seeing certain things because I was not able to walk there. I might have been able to walk to the place, but I knew I was too weak to walk back.

He and I sat in the car and waited for the couple to

go do what was on the agenda and we rested. One day I was so exhausted I didn't even want to get in the car and go anywhere. I needed a day of rest so badly and later found out my husband did as well. We took in as much as we could and then walked to the car. Got in and waited for our friends to come back. An hour and a half later I awoke, feeling better.

God worked out so many things for us. There were times my husband and I would be waiting in the car for them to come back or just having time by ourselves where we would laugh and talk about something that had happened earlier.

My husband and I both had favor of the Lord, with parking, our rooms, food, etc. The beautiful mountains were such a blessing! I had always wanted to see the Swiss Alps since a child and there I was, standing on the mountain top. Favor! The weather was cool. And it was not raining! We walked in the clouds! God worked out every detail. He knew my health was not up to par, but I continued to confess that I was the healed of the Lord, and I am sure that is what kept me going. I was not about to let the devil rob me of this trip of a lifetime. We were celebrating 50 years of marriage which is the favor of God too! We were given a free gift at a store just because Dean told her we were celebrating our 50th anniversary. Favor! It was an adorable German cup, saucer and spoon in a beautiful Christmas box.


