If you need to have your faith come up to the next level, you will find how to do it.

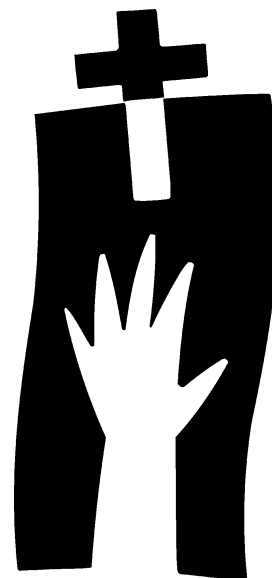
Sunday services begin at 10:00 a.m. There are also opportunities galore for those interested in donating their time and talents.

The Blood of Jesus

"Oh the Blood of Jesus, Oh the Blood of Jesus,
Oh the Blood of Jesus it washes white as snow."
That's how the song goes. What an amazing power
the Blood of Jesus has!

When we confess our sin and invite Him into our hearts, making Him the Lord of our life, we are instantly forgiven of our sin and instantly washed white as snow. From then on it's our job to learn how to walk according to the Word of God.

We have to learn how to think like Jesus does, treat others like Jesus would, talk without using swear words and love like Jesus does. It's always our choice as to the kind of walk we live. We either live for Jesus, or we live for the enemy, the devil. I don't like to think that we might be serving the devil by the words we speak, or by the way we act, but that's how it is!

The Bible tells us we have been cleansed inside by the Blood of Jesus so why spoil a good thing. It's a great blessing for us to be cleansed inside and forgiven of our sin. The problem is that we don't forgive ourselves when we have done something wrong. We allow the enemy to condemn us and then we agree with him.

When we became saved through the Blood of Jesus, our sins were covered, forgiven and forgotten. We were given the mind of Christ so that we could learn to think like He does instead of our old way, but sometimes we choose to listen to the enemy and agree with his negative words to us.

The Bible says, we have the mind of Christ so then it's up to us to read the Bible and find out what the mind of Christ is like. When you read the Bible, you begin to see how He thinks. He always walked in love toward everyone and spoke positively toward them. He was and is a positive God. If He were negative, crabby and always tearing us down, we wouldn't really want to follow Him or be

like Him. He has such good plans for our lives that were made before we were even born. All good ones! Then when we received Jesus as our Savior, the plan began to take place. Changes in our lives took us to new places, new friends, for some new jobs. We didn't go to the places we used to go. We made better choices for our entertainment. We read better books and watched better television programs. We stopped swearing and telling dirty jokes. We changed for the better.

I will never understand why people who swear think those words are so important. They are empty, and fillers when they don't know what to say. They are meaningless.

You hear people take the name of the Lord in vain, but you never hear them use Buddha or some other strange god in their conversation. That's because the devil knows there is no power in those other names.

Jesus has power in His Name and power in His Blood. When we plea the Blood of Jesus over ourselves, our families, our homes, jobs, finances, and property, we are protected. The enemy cannot stand the Blood of Jesus. When the enemy sees it he passes over us and goes on to someone else. Do you want to be overlooked by the devil? Sure you do!

Start to **plea the Blood of Jesus out loud every day** over all those things I just mentioned. Draw a line in the sand between you and the devil. He can't cross the line of Blood and trip you up. You deserve to be taken care of.

When Jesus went to Heaven, He sat down at the right hand of the Father. He said, "Ok, I'm done now it's your turn. I died for you, so it's up to you to use my Blood along with the Words in the manual, the Bible." When you are covered with the Blood of Jesus and you speak God's Word out loud, the devil

and his demons are defeated. They will not cross the Blood line of Jesus.

The Blood of Jesus was shed for us. That's what it says when we take communion. Either you believe it, or you don't! It will make you strong to put the Blood of Jesus over you, your family, your job, possessions, and your finances. The demons will not be able to get to you in the same way the death angel passed by the homes that had the Blood of the Lamb on the door posts, in the Bible. Put the Blood of Jesus over your home.

When you are sick, plea the Blood of Jesus over yourself and find a Scripture that fits your situation. II Peter 2:24 says, "By the stripes of Jesus you WERE healed." If you were, then you are healed. You have the Holy Spirit living on the inside of you, so draw on His healing virtue. Say; "Holy Spirit You are in me so I receive the healing that belongs to me, by the stripes of Jesus I was healed, so I believe I am healed now. By faith, I choose to believe the Word and receive all I need physically, in Jesus Name."

Sickness did not come from the Lord Jesus! He died for it so we might be made whole, body, soul and spirit.

There is such power in His Blood, it can heal marriages, restore families, heal your body, restore your soul and renew your spirit. Nothing is too difficult for Him. He is the answer for everything in our lives. But we can't sit there and do nothing! We have to get busy and read our Bible and know what He is telling us. When we know, we can act on it and then receive the changes it brings into our lives.

He came that we might be made whole. So many have been through stuff in their lives and they don't feel whole anymore. They feel broken, yet it is merely a choice they make as to whether they choose to stay that way or choose to serve the Lord Jesus and receive all the healing He has for them. They can choose to stay in that place of self-centered poor me, or not! "I can't serve God, I have too many troubles." What a goofy thought! Where

did it come from? It came from the program of the enemy in your mind. Get a new program. When you need help in any area of your life, reach for your Bible and find out what the Word does for you.

One verse says, "The Word is life to us and health to our flesh." Honey, that's provision! We can receive new life in us just by reading a verse in the Bible. That's incredible! We can receive health by reading the Word. One verse can bring better health than one hundred pills. Which will you choose? No, I'm not telling you to throw out your pills, I'm telling you to get in the Word and you won't need those pills.

He was born as a baby yet eventually died on a cross **shedding His Blood for us**. Receive Him today and know that you can be healed of your brokenness. You can be restored! You can have new life.

The rest of this year and in the new year begin to speak out loud; **"I plea the Blood of Jesus over me, my family, finances, property, and draw a line between the enemy and me in Jesus Name. Enemy, you can't cross the Blood line of Jesus so you flee now and don't come back in Jesus Name."**

You will receive such victory in your life you will wonder why you didn't do that before. Get in the Bible and read what Jesus did for you and what He has for you now.

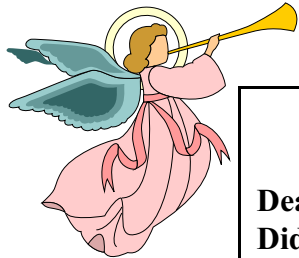

I'm a worshiper so I can get lost in His Presence when I worship. Praise is good too, but worship is more my thing. I like to hear the church when they become strong in praise in worship. Sometimes it drowns out your thoughts, which is great. We want our thoughts to be on Him anyway.

I was reading a book recently where a certain church really knew how to praise the Lord. They got into praise so loud they shouted the roof down so to speak. They shouted long and loud. They began to shout from their heart and the more they praised the more they didn't want to stop. In fact they praised so much and so loud the pastor couldn't even get their attention to stop. Finally, he put a large bell on the podium to ring when he wanted them to stop. He would ring and ring and ring it. Then the people would begin to quiet down and eventually stop so he could preach. Pretty soon she had another vision of her two baskets, the one with the mountain, which had the impossible situation in it, the small pox. It was empty and it had left! The other basket was overflowing with her praises.

She told the doctor she had to continue to praise the Lord for each small pox she had. The small pox all left her and she never even had one scar from them.

Begin to praise God as you are in your situation and know that it **is** changing and then that **it has** changed. We speak that which is not as though it is.

Ephesians 2:6 tells us we are seated with Christ. "By grace God has raised us up together and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus."

Thank You Father for this seat You have given us here. You have told us to rule and reign over darkness. And that You have delivered us from the power of darkness. If He has delivered us why do

we act like He hasn't?

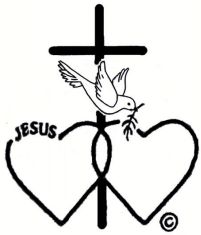
