


Nothing will ever be bigger than God! He can take care of anything.

God has the final Word



When God is preparing His people for something new, He first prepares us by **allowing** us to go through some trouble. That trouble causes us to put our dependence on Him. We become more grounded in Him and get self out of the way.

God is always wanting to build something new inside of you. He is always wanting us to change in one way or the other. So we might just as well say, "Ok Lord, change me, do what You want to within me."

Your dependEncy has to be on the Lord, not on your ability. If we think we can do it by ourselves, God will get in the picture and reveal to you that you can't. He doesn't want proud arrogant people. He wants us to have a humble dependency on Him.

Hopelessness can get in you when you continue to look at your situation that hasn't changed yet, but God says, "Look to Me, I am your hope. I will change it as you change."

The hopelessness, despair, depression are burdens that come from the enemy. We have been given power over the enemy so that we can live in freedom. The Word tells us we are to cast our burdens upon the Lord.

God will reverse the work of

the enemy. Jesus came to show us the way out of our darkness. There is no person, situation, or trouble that is beyond God's ability to change it.

Nothing will ever be bigger than God! He can take care of any thing.

In Genesis 1:2 it talks about the Spirit of God hovering. God wants us to know that His Spirit is still hovering today.

On Tuesday nights when we have prayed and just sit in His Presence, He is hovering and we wait to see what great thing is going to happen. Sometimes, each one is ministered to while other times it is a corporate blessing.

A peace comes with His hovering and a change takes place within us. We become more peaceful, and we remember He is able to handle whatever it is we are dealing with. Sometimes He speaks to our hearts to encourage us to keep going and not give up.

We love to welcome Him into our situation. We want His Presence! Remember when He hovers it is because He is ready to move and He wants us to move with Him. His hovering won't last forever in our situation because His work is time sensitive. We have to be ready to do whatever it is He wants.

Maybe He will give someone direction as to what to do next. Maybe He will have a specific direction we are to take. You can have that same thing going on in your own time with Him.

When you are aware of His Presence, welcome Him and tell Him you want Him and you want what He has for you. Begin to praise Him and even before you know the answer, begin to thank Him for the victory. That keeps your faith going too, because if you are thanking Him then you must believe that He is taking care of your burdens or that He is changing you. We need to cooperate with Him.

There isn't any darkness, confusion, or problem that has the final word. Only God has the final Word!

God always wants to bring light into darkness. So when you sense God hovering over you or your family, you can know that He is preparing to creatively transform something to bring light into the darkness.

Remember, first **God** hovers and then He creates.

We always need to nurture His presence and wait on Him. Welcome His presence, cherish Him, let your hope replace despair. When God begins to hover and you are aware of it, wait on Him. Don't get your mind busy thinking about something. Soak His Presence in! Trust Him! If you do this, you will end up feeling refreshed and revived.

In the story of Mary and Martha, Mary simply came into Jesus' Presence and waited, listening to His words. Martha busied herself with work. Martha's work was not wrong, but her timing was off. There is a time to work and a time to wait, but it is not a time for doing when you enter His Presence. It is a time for simply being in His Presence.

God releases His power in the waiting. You will be transformed. You will be able to run without any weariness and walk without fainting, because you waited until He created something new inside of you that is for the purpose of going forward in His strength and power, rather than yours.

Col. 1:13 says, "The Father has delivered and drawn us to Himself out of the control and the dominion of darkness and has transferred us into the kingdom of the Son of His love." (Amplified Bible.)

God is not only light, He is love. He hears our cries, He comes, He hovers, He does whatever is necessary to turn our faces back to His. He closes the distance. He conquers the void in us. Even when people have seemingly turned their backs to Him, He will turn them around because of His love for them. Our job is to walk in love toward them no matter what and trust God that He is changing them and us.

Jesus came to us as the Light of the World! He lightens our darkness by opening our blind eyes and freeing us from those places where darkness has imprisoned us. When you read the Word and you get a revelation, that revelation causes the light of God to overthrow darkness.

When God sheds His light on a situation, you can see what to do and you can hold on in prayer until God's will is accomplished.

Isaiah 60:1 says, "Arise, shine; for your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you."

We have to come out of the darkness and step into the light in order for us to have a new day. Each night we go to bed it is intended as a time of rest, refreshment and renewal for the new day. It is a time to regroup and get ready to meet the new days' challenges.

As we go through the beginning of each new day, we seem to step into what seems to be a small war; a time of testing.

Sometimes, we feel so disconnected as we make our

way into whatever new thing God has for us. But we also need to disconnect with the old ideas, beliefs, and emotions.

In the story of Ruth we have read that she was willing to disconnect from her past, she was the one who stepped into the new day. She was blessed and her mother-in-law was blessed. Ruth obeyed her mother-in-law. She died to self.



Now in this midnight hour, death comes to us where we completely surrender to God. We must put all of our trust in God's hands, because His Word is always the final Word!





Power in His Name

We all know that there is power in the Name of Jesus, so let me show you some of the principles that are involved in His Name.

It says in Colossians 2:15 - "And having spoiled principalities and power, He made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it."

Because Jesus died and rose from the dead, He conquered principalities, powers, rulers of the darkness and dominions. He put to nothing principalities and powers, He triumphed **over** them. In other words He paralyzed them.

Ephesians 6:12 says, "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."

The principalities and powers we wrestle against are the same ones that He overcame and put to nothing. No wonder He said, "In My Name they will cast out demons." Jesus met satan and his demons on their own turf and **defeated** them.

All that Jesus did or triumphed over, the devil, sin, sickness, disease, etc. is all wrapped up in His Name. His Name belongs to us. Say "HIS NAME BELONGS TO ME." By our using His Name, it brings reality into our lives of what Jesus has already

accomplished. That's one of the reasons the devil has fought so hard to keep people from knowing about it.

We can repeat of something over and over like a parrot saying, "Polly wants a cracker," and nothing happens for you at all. But when you know what is behind His Name, when you know what Jesus did, that He rose, and that He said, "All authority is given unto me, in heaven and in earth. Go, I'm giving **you** My Name, and My authority." You know you can take that Name to the bank, so to speak.

Colossians 1:13 says, "Who has delivered us from the power or authority of darkness and has translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son."

It was in His spoiling the principalities and powers, putting them to nothing, overcoming them, defeating them, that He delivered us from the power of darkness. That means from the power or authority of satan. Say, "I am delivered!"

When you really know this truth and know that the Name belongs to you, you can put the devil on the run every time. I mean every single time!

"Well Pastor Hart, I tried that and it didn't work." Well maybe you need to repent for lying and God will forgive you. It did work! God has delivered you from the power of darkness, from the authority of darkness, from the authority of satan and his kingdom. He has translated us into the kingdom of His Dear Son. Jesus, triumphed over them and they were brought to nothing and they were **dethroned**.

So why is the devil, depression, oppression, demons, sickness and everything else that is of the devil ruling so many Christians and even churches? Maybe because they do not **know** what belongs to them and their faith has not grown. The word "know" is so important.

The Name of Jesus is not a good luck charm. You can't think, "Maybe if I try using the Name of Jesus it might work." No way! You have to know it will work.

Remember the demons are not going to **be** dethroned, they **are** dethroned. The demons have no right to rule us.

The Name of Jesus stands for all of His authority and power!

The more you allow the Word to become a part of your inner consciousness, it will start working for you.

Jesus Name is above every name. Heaven, earth and hell realize what that Name means. We have authority in that Name. It was given to us. So do you have a key to your house? Of course, you are the authorized one who has authority over your home. Jesus took the keys of hell and of death, so He has the authority over that now.

Matthew 28:18 says, "All power, or authority is given to me in heaven and in earth." Then in Matthew 28:19, He delegated His authority in the earth to the Church. And when He did, He **promised**, that these signs shall follow them that **believe** in His Name.

Mark 16:17,18 tells us that in the Name of Jesus, He authorized us and He gave us His Name as the authority. The **Power** is in the Name. The **authority** is in the Name. His Name is above every name. His Name is recognized in three worlds, heaven, earth, and under the earth.

Angels, men and demons have to bow at that Name and that Name belongs to us. We are authorized to use that Name.

There is no other Name given under heaven where we must be saved. Acts 4:12. So, there is salvation in His Name. His Name has all the power all majesty and all glory today.

The Father God has lifted Jesus to the **highest position** of the universe. Jesus is seated at the right hand of the Father on high, far above every known authority. God the Father has given Him the **highest Name** in the universe and He has bestowed upon Him honor,

glory and power. His Name is all authority, all power, all the dignity, all the majesty and all the glory that Jesus the Person has. The Name stands for the Person. And this Name is given to us.

We have been given a rich inheritance, the Name of Jesus!

So many times we think we have to pray all the Scriptures we know, but many times there isn't time to do that, or you just can't seem to remember them to pray. Well honey, there is more power in the name of Jesus than anything. Just repeat the name of Jesus, worship Him, sing Jesus, Jesus, Jesus over and over, the power will come and all you have to do is receive it. There is **power in His Name.**

If your mind could only grasp the fact that satan is paralyzed, and stripped of his armor by Jesus and that at the name of Jesus the demons must depart. They have no choice.

I believe that before Jesus returns there is going to be a mighty army of believers who will learn the secret of living in the Name of Jesus and will reign in life, living a victorious, resurrected life.

You have already been forgiven of your sin if you are a born-again believer. You are a new creature. You don't just have forgiveness of sins, you have become the righteousness of God in Christ and you are to dominate (rule over) sin.

II John 4:4 says, "Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world."

The devil doesn't want you to know you have power over him. All power and authority has already been given to you through the Name of Jesus.

Use the Name of Jesus. It's powerful!

It's such a special time of year and I don't want it to end without giving you a chance to receive Jesus into your heart.

If you have never received Jesus, pray this prayer:

Dear Lord.

I believe Jesus is the Son of God. I believe He died on the cross and took all my sin. I repent of them and invite Jesus to come into my heart and live with me forever. I ask Him to fill me to overflowing with His Holy Spirit.


